**Implementation Status and Key Decisions**

The Project was approved by the World Bank on December 18, 2020. The Project Financing Agreement was signed on March 9 and became effective on June 4, 2021. The Government has established the Project Implementation Unit and is finalizing the safeguards instruments. The government transition resulting from the November 2021 elections has impacted the progress of project activities although these are expected to resume promptly now that the new Minister for the Fondo Hondureño de Inversión Social/SEDECOAS has been appointed.

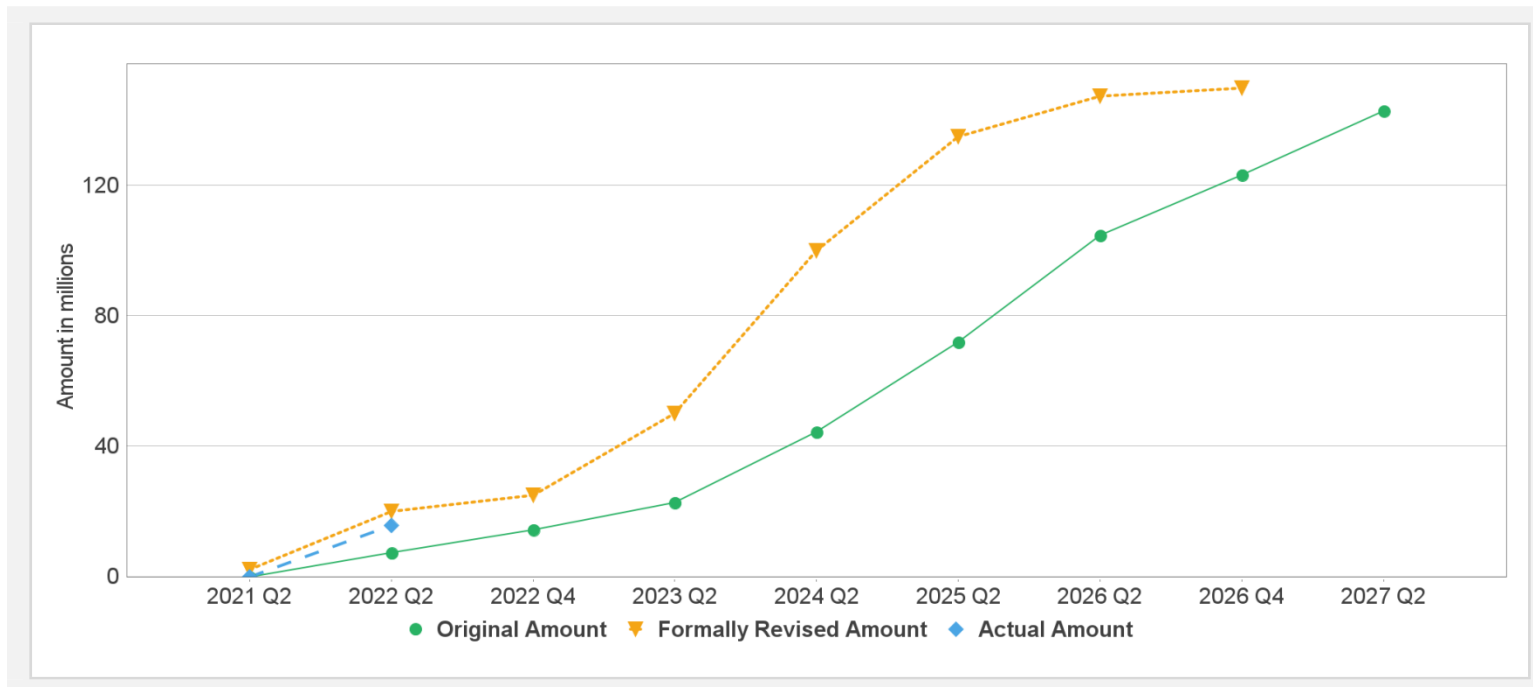
