Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project implementation is progressing well reflected by the following achievements:

- More than 74 000 farmers reached with agricultural assets or services, of which 27 530 women and 26 214 youth.
- Increase in yield of targeted products achieved by project direct beneficiaries (25% on rice, 15% on fish, 14% on maize, 8% on potato and eggs)
- 28 000 Ha area under improved technologies diffused by the project
- More than 67 000 users of improved technologies disseminated by the project out of which 34 000 are women
- 1425 agricultural extension agents trained
- Implementation progress is also commensurate with good progress in the disbursement rate which rose from 41% to 50% with a fiscal year disbursement ratio of 33%.



- 3310 ha have been put under rehabilitation (rice schemes perimeters)
- The CERC activation for US\$4 million and additional US\$ 1 million through the project activities were mobilized to support SME as part of the government's COVID-19 Response Plan with the follows (i) protecting vulnerable household to support local production and availability of rice and maize. The project helped by suppling about 40 000 vulnerable household who benefited from 22,500 kits of rice and maize, market gardening (modern input), poultry breeding and aquaculture across the country (ii) supporting 115 micro project and SMEs in the agri-food sector through two business plan competitions, (iii) establishing the digital food security platform to monitor the impact of the Covid 19 pandemic on the agriculture and food security system.


