4. KEY ISSUES & STATUS

4.1 Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project was approved on June 14, 2023 and signed on August 17, 2023. It is still pending effectiveness, with a second extension made until April 26, 2024. Key implementation status includes:

- The need to finalize the recruitment of the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) as the last effectiveness condition, which has experienced significant delays.
- Finalizing the output agreements with implementing agencies for the quick win activities in the North and East to ensure that these quick win interventions begin rapidly to have a significant impact over the coming months.
- Preparing for the second phase of project implementation through the launch of a study that will target more long-term economic development, large-scale interventions, and capacity-building efforts.


