Excellency:

I refer to the Grant Agreement (the "Agreement") between the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Development Association (the "Bank"), acting as administrator of Global Partnership for Sustainable and Resilient Landscapes Multi-Donor Trust Fund and the Kyrgyz Republic (the "Recipient") for the above-referenced Project. The Standard Conditions, as defined in the Grant Agreement, provide that the Bank may issue additional instructions regarding the withdrawal of the proceeds of PROGREEN Grant No. TF C3588-KG (the "PROGREEN Grant"), and may set out Project specific financial reporting requirements. This letter ("Disbursement and Financial Information Letter" or "DFIL"), as revised from time to time, constitutes such additional instructions.

I. Disbursement Arrangements and Withdrawal of Grant Funds

The Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, dated February 2017, ("Disbursement Guidelines") are available in the Bank's public website at https://www.worldbank.org and its secure website "Client Connection" at https://clientconnection.worldbank.org. The Disbursement Guidelines are an integral part of the DFIL, and the manner in which the provisions in the guidelines apply to the Grant is specified below.

(i) Disbursement Arrangements

The table in **Schedule 1** provides the disbursement methods which may be used by the Recipient, information on registration of authorized signatures, processing of withdrawal applications (including minimum value of applications and advances), instructions on supporting documentation, and frequency of reporting on the Designated Account.

(ii) Withdrawal of Grant Funds (Electronic Delivery) Section 7.01 (c) of the Standard Conditions.

The Recipient will deliver Withdrawal Applications (with supporting documents) electronically through the Bank's web-based portal "Client Connection" at https://clientconnection.worldbank.org. This option will be effected after the officials designated in writing by the Recipient who are authorized to sign and deliver Withdrawal Applications have registered as users of "Client Connection". The designated officials will deliver Applications electronically by completing the Form 2380, which is accessible through



"Client Connection". By signing the Authorized Signatory Letter, the Recipient confirms that it is authorizing such persons to accept Secure Identification Credentials (SIDC) and to deliver the Applications and supporting documents to the Bank by electronic means. The Recipient may exercise the option of preparing and delivering Withdrawal Applications in paper form on exceptional cases (including those where the Recipient encounters legal limitations), and which were previously agreed with the Bank. By designating officials to use SIDC and by choosing to deliver the Applications electronically, the Recipient confirms through the authorized signatory letter its agreement to: (a) abide by the Terms and Conditions of Use of Secure Identification Credentials in connection with Use of Electronic Means to Process Applications and Supporting Documentation, available in the Bank's public website at https://www.worldbank.org and "Client Connection" at https://clientconnection.worldbank.org; and (b) to cause such official to abide by those terms and conditions.

II. Financial Reports and Audits Section 2.07 (a) and (b) of the Standard Conditions.

- (i) Financial Reports. The Recipient shall through the PIU of MoES prepare and furnish to the Bank not later than forty-five (45) days after the end of each calendar quarter, interim unaudited financial reports (IFR) for the Project, covering the quarter, in form and substance satisfactory to the Bank, commencing with the calendar quarter in which the first withdrawal was made.
- (ii) Audits. Each audit of the Project Financial Statements shall cover the period of one fiscal year of the Recipient, commencing with the fiscal year in which the first withdrawal was made. The audited Project Financial Statements for each such period shall be furnished to the Bank by the Recipient through the PIU of MoES, not later than six (6) months after the end of such period.

The Bank recommends that you register as a user of "Client Connection". - 2) No withdrawal shall be made under this PROGREEN Grant (PROGREEN TF C3588-KG) for eligible expenditure that have already been financed from the other Financings under the Project (IDA 7490-KG and KWPF TF C3586-KG), or for which withdrawals have been requested under these Financings, and vice versa.
