Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Government of Morocco has made significant progress regarding the implementation of the policy program supported by the Morocco Cat DDO: i) The Fonds de Solidarité contre les Évènements Catastrophiques (Solidarity Fund, FSEC) has continued strengthening its human resources and has been receiving, since 2020, regular revenues from the parafiscal tax that exceeded initial targets; ii) the development of the online platform for the registration of victims of catastrophic events has made significant progress and is in its final phase; iii) insurance companies have built up prudential reserves to strengthen their financial capacity against catastrophic events; iv) Morocco's institutional capacity for flood management is being strengthened through the implementation of an integrated flood risk management system in four pilot zones, which is about to be operationalized; and v) the Civil Protection continued strengthening its human resources, especially with focus on skills upgrading of its staff.


