Until now, the share of female permanent employment has not been collected by the PIU. However, following guidance from the Task Team, the PIU will begin collecting gender-disaggregated data for this indicator.

#### Comments:

The task team notes that the achievement of the indicator appears high if compared with the small number of business plans currently under implementation. The mission checked these numbers and they appear to be those actually provided by the RPOs, as validated by the PSDEs. The figure is in any case aligned with the experience in the previous COMRURAL I Project, where 121 business plans created an estimated 24,673 permanent and temporary jobs. Nonetheless, the team expects that this indicator will change in the next ISR, where the Results Framework will be measured using the clear guidance in the new indicator sheets that the PIU just completed with support from the task team.

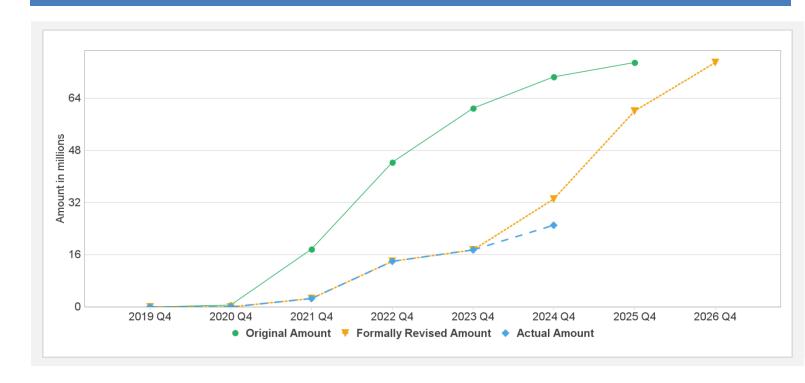
