#### 4. KEY ISSUES & STATUS

#### 4.1 Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project was officially launched on January 23, 2024 by the Ministry of Economy, Planning and International Cooperation and the World Bank Representative.

The project has three main components: 1) Strengthening Central Systems Underpinning Decentralization and Enhancing Local Capacity for Service Delivery 2) Resilient Communities 3) Socio-economic reintegration of ex-combatants. It will cover four provinces: Lobaye, Basse-Kotto, Mbomou and Vakaga.

A number of workshops have been held and manuals and policy documents, including the grievance mechanism have been developed.

The project will include participatory climate risk assessments, and a manual for that work was tested in Bangui and Mbaiki in the end of May/early June, 2024.


