### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project is progressing moderately satisfactorily towards the Project Development Objectives, with around 192 km of roads completely rehabilitated (up from 74 km in November 2022), 157 km of roads substantially completed (pending signage and marking) and around 648,000 labor-days generated as of end of May 2023.

7/26/2023 Page 1 of 7 26,687 small-scale Lebanese farmers have benefited from the voucher support program. 
