Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project is expected to increase economic opportunities and revenue from tourism and the broader nature-based economy sector by improving the enabling environment, engaging key stakeholders, financing key basic infrastructure, and providing matching grants to communities for investments in the nature-based economy. The project Financing Agreement (FA) was signed on July 15, 2023 and Effectiveness is expected by October 13, 2023 after three pre-agreed effectiveness conditions are met: (a) establishment of a project implementation Unit; (b) adaptation of a project operations manual; and (c) development of terms of reference for conducting a Strategic Environmental and Social Assessment.

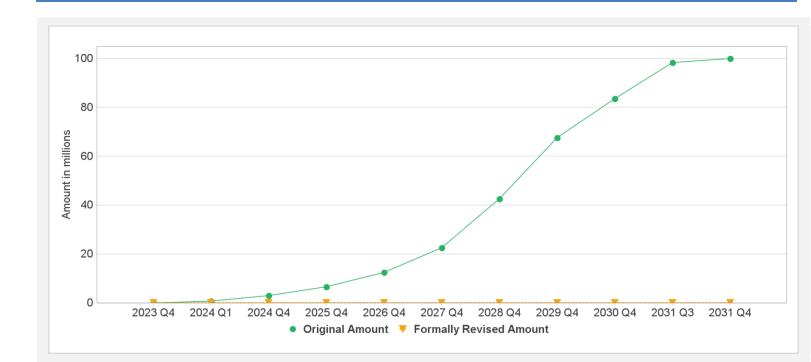
