Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Rio Grande do Norte Regional Development and Governance is a US\$400 million Project, which is financed by a US\$360 million IBRD loan and US\$40 million counterpart financing. The project has three components: (i) Regional Sustainable Development with investments on roads, cultural sites, tourism sites, sewage and water supply infrastructure and sustainable economic inclusion of small-scale farmers (including vulnerable groups); (ii) Public Services Improvement with investments on public health (hospital construction and upgrades) and education (schools construction and upgrades); and (iii) Public Sector Management with investments in public safety, municipal and fiscal controls, development of data mining tools for the tax department and mapping and securing state properties. The Project has completed all Project activities. It has disbursed 100% of loan funds. Financial management and procurement, alongside social and environmental ratings, have been assessed as satisfactory.

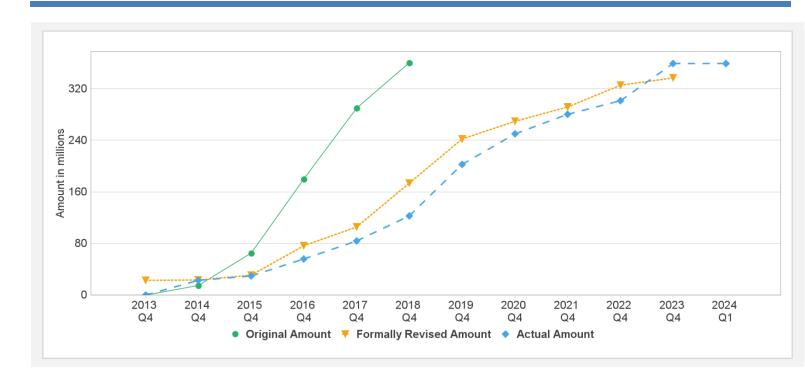
