Implementation Status and Key Decisions

This ISR is based on the implementation support mission carried from November 8 to 29, 2021.

The AGCOM project has made impressive progress in recent months. Therefore, both key project ratings are being upgraded to 'satisfactory'. The most notable achievements are the following:

85 producer organizations with 28,964 beneficiaries (12,638 men, 16,326 women and 7,146 being youth) have received matching grants and are doing the investments on the ground.

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- The total value of the active portfolio of subprojects has increased to approximately US\$12 million, and farmers have already mobilized US\$1.2 million of own contributions to match the grants.
- 25 organizations, which commenced the subprojects earlier, are already showing an increase of 16,000 metric tons in volume traded with
 off takers, a 13% increase only in the first year. This represents approximately a US\$12 million increase in sales with respect to the
 previous year. If the trend continues, the Project will largely exceed the targets.
- AGCOM is now benefiting producer organizations in 19 value chains, with half of the subprojects being in dairy and soya. The approach has proved to be effective in promoting the much-needed productive diversification in Malawi.
- On top of the matching grants, the Project is supporting a partial credit guarantee, which helps farmers access private financing. Currently, already one producer organization is accessing a loan supported by that facility and we expect that the uptake will continue to grow.
- The Project is also preparing about US\$15 million in public infrastructure investments linked to the commercial agriculture. This includes
 roads, bridges, and irrigation schemes, which are strategic for the producer organizations that are doing business, supported by the
 Project.
- AGCOM has sparked significant interest among farmers and, so far, 997 concept notes have been received. AGCOM provides matching
 grants based on calls for proposals. Currently 140 proposals from organizations have been approved and 85 have already signed the
 subproject agreements.

Overall Comments

With the restructuring carried out after the Mid-Term Review, the target of sales was adjusted to an increase of 15,000 metric tons per year equivalent to US\$10 million. The calculation was based on subproject documents of several alliances that had been approved at that time. The first set of real sales data suggest that the target was underestimated, and the Project outcomes are likely to be larger than the projections.


