#### 4. KEY ISSUES & STATUS

### 4.1 Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The second project restructuring appointing INAGE as the implementation agency for activities related to government service delivery leveraging technology was approved in June 2024 and INAGE project implementation unit is operational. Overall implementation progress remains Moderately Unsatisfactory due to continued procurement delays for key activities. Agreement has been reached on actions needed to accelerate activities. The CERC closed on November 4, 2024. Over US\$ 32 million supported CERC activities in the agriculture and health sectors. Another restructuring will be processed to retain \$5 million for the project and cancel the remaining unused funds.


