### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Project Implementation is on track upon effectiveness on June 28, 2023. The PIU is fully staffed and counts on additional support from WB team and consultants. The Strategic Committee has been created. Overall project implementation remains satisfactory. As of November 21, 2023, 4% of the first disbursement has been implemented (USD\$53,232.36) and 45% committed (USD 672,744.55) (projected until December 2023). The next disbursement request is expected by Q3 FY24. The GRM is working with a physical mailbox available in Spanish and Haitian Creole, as well as a digital mailbox available 24/7, along with telephone and WhatsApp lines available during business hours. The Operations Manual, Labor Management Procedures (LMP), Electronic Waste Management Plan (EWMP), Environmental and Social Screening Checklist (E&S Checklist), E&S Training Plan, and an updated version of the Stakeholder Engagement Plan (SEP) have been finalized, approved, disclosed, and shared with all project workers and contractors.


