Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Activities under component 1 have now been completed with only 2 sub-projects expected to be handed-over/inauguration by end of November 2022. Achievements to date include the rehabilitation of 5 kilometers of non-rural roads as planned to improve communities access to basic services. The selection of urban roads (PK5 and Bambari) and a bridge (Kaga Bandoro) as sub-projects was prioritized, based on priority needs identified by communities, to generate temporary jobs through labor intensive public works (LIPW). LIPW created 120,415 person-days of employment, surpassing the target 80,000 person-days jobs. 101,230 beneficiaries, of which 78 percent are women and 63 percent are displaced

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people, have seen their urban living conditions improved, surpassing the target of 99,000 beneficiaries. Going forward only cash transfer activities (component 2) and community mobilization and accompanying measures (component 3) will be supported.

Despite significant initial delays, the project has been able to exceed its initial target of 30,000 beneficiaries under the additional financing cash transfers, providing 33,000 households with at least one payment in Bangui, Bria and Bouar. As a result, cash transfers have reached 246,325 individual, 75 percent of them women and 80 displaced people. Nevertheless, these transfers were carried out with at least a 6-month delay which will require adjustments either to the project timeline or payment schedule, which will be discussed over the coming months.

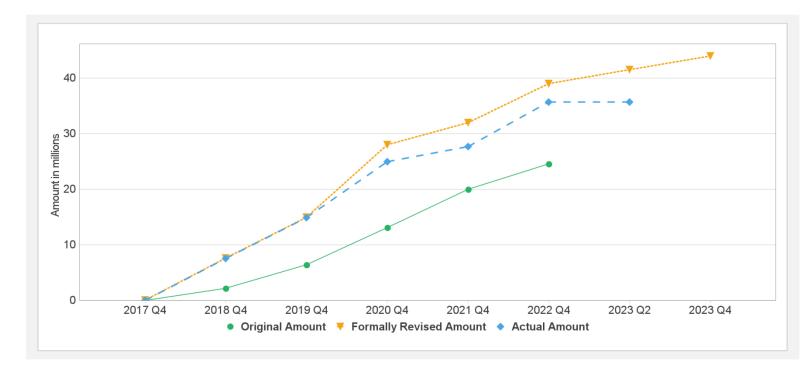
