Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project continues to progress despite the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under Component 1, Integrated Curriculum Reform, writing of the new curricula is complete for all grades apart from Nursery 2 which is in draft format. The Project supported the development of guidance for teachers on curriculum prioritization in grades 1-9 in the context of the pandemic. Activities related to the piloting of a comprehensive student assessment system has progressed well and the PIU and MOE are collaborating closely with Cyril Potter College to incorporate the renewed curriculum to the pre-service teacher training. Under Component 2, the evaluations for bids for the University of Guyana Faculty of Health Sciences (FHS) building has been finalized and the highest scored bid awaits signing. Given the challenges due to the pandemic, cancellation of the National Grade 2 Exam, and delay in project implementation, the Project will be restructured.


