Implementation Status and Key Decisions



This ISR covers the period June to November 2021.

Overall implementation progress is positive despite the COVID-19 pandemic. The construction of the Fecal Sludge Treatment Plant (FSTP) in Semé-Podji will be completed by end of December 2021. The construction of the 16 multi-village rural water supply systems is ongoing and will be completed in 2022. The construction of the national laboratory for water quality started in November 2021.


