Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Project implementation continues in the context of the ongoing COVID-19 emergency. The first group of 20 Business Plans with Rural Producer Organizations (benefitting 2,685 families; 34 percent are led by women; 16 percent are young people; 18 percent are indigenous and afro-Hondurans) is starting implementation with total investments of US\$13.2 million, of which private capital mobilization is worth US\$7.0 million. Additional 29 Business Plans are well-advanced in preparation, which is expected to speed up implementation in the first semester of 2022. Progress will be monitored in a virtual mission preliminary planned for March 2022.


