## Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The fourth implementation support mission (ISM) for the CNP was conducted from August 16th to 20th, 2021. The domestic COVID-19 restrictions have caused inevitable yet significant delays in the rollout of activities including: the quarterly assessment of health facilities using the Maternal and Child Health and Nutrition Scorecard (MCHN-S); the rollout of the Commune/Sangkat Service Delivery Grant (C/S-SDG); and the Health Equity Fund (HEF) expansion. However, CNP's two implementing agencies, Ministry of Health and National Committee for Sub-National Democratic Development Secretariat, have made notable progress since the last ISM held in February 2021. For instance, the Payment Certification Agency started certifying the claim verification for the new HEF beneficiaries (0-2 years old children of informal workers) in June 2021. The information, communication and technology platform for the MCHN-S has also been developed and is ready for the operational district assessors' training in December 2021. Furthermore, the NCDDS has conducted its first round of the C/S-SDG readiness assessment at commune/Sangkat (C/S) and district/municipal administration (DMA) in October and November 2021 as part of the commune/Sangkat SDG rollout plan. The first SDG payment to C/S and DMA will be completed by end of December 2021.

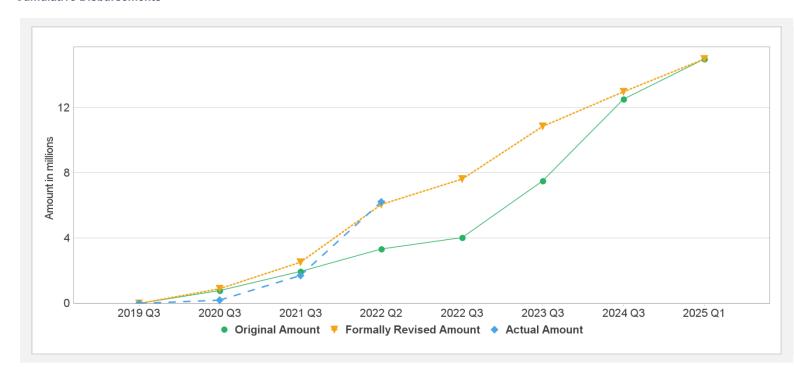
