Implementation Status and Key Decisions

This project has supported the establishment of the Innovative Startups and SMEs Fund (ISSF), a US\$98 million Fund of Funds of which US\$50 million is co-financed through an IBRD Loan. It was approved by the World Bank's Board of Executive Directors on June 23, 2017. The ISSF was launched in Jordan on September 23, 2018. The project was restructured May 5, 2020 to mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 outbreak on the Jordanian entrepreneurial and startup ecosystem. The ISSF is actively receiving applications from the private sector for investment and support, including the deployment of the newly introduced COVID-19 convertible notes.

To date, ISSF activities have benefited 426 startups and innovative SMEs with equity/ quasi-equity (directly and indirectly) and trainings across all sectors. ISSF has become Jordan one-stop shop for the innovation ecosystem and has crowded-in \$44.63M of private capital from more than 26 local, regional and global co-investors. Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, ISSF made notable progress across all four activities under the Deal-Flow Creation Support namely the Entrepreneurship Enablement & Development Program (EEDP), Jordan's Angel Investor Network (JAIN), the


