PROJECT AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT, dated April 28, 2000, between INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION (the Association) and AGENCE D'EXECUTION DES TRAVAUX D'INTERET PUBLIC CONTRE LE SOUS-EMPLOI (AGETIP)

WHEREAS (A) by the Development Credit Agreement of even date herewith between Republic of Senegal (the Borrower) and the Association, the Association has agreed to make available to the Borrower an amount in various currencies equivalent to thirty-six million seven hundred thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR 36,700,000), on the terms and conditions set forth in the Development Credit Agreement, but only on conditions that AGETIP agree to undertake such obligations toward the Association as are set forth in this Agreement;

(B) by a Convention entered into between the Borrower and AGETIP, a portion of the proceeds of the credit provided for under the Development Credit Agreement will be made available to AGETIP on the terms and conditions set forth in said Convention; and

WHEREAS AGETIP, in consideration of the Association's entering into the Development Credit Agreement with the Borrower, has agreed to

undertake the obligations set forth in this Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

Definitions

Section 1.01. Unless the context otherwise requires, the several terms defined in the Development Credit Agreement, the Preamble to this Agreement and in the General Conditions (as so defined) have the respective meanings therein set forth.

ARTICLE II

Execution of the Project

Section 2.01. (a) AGETIP declares its commitment to the objectives of the Project as set forth in Schedule 2 to the Development Credit Agreement and, to this end, shall carry out Part B.14 of the Project with due diligence and efficiency and in conformity with appropriate administrative, financial, engineering and educational practices, and shall provide, or cause to be provided, promptly as needed, the funds, facilities, services and other resources required for Part B.14 of the Project.

(b) Without limitation upon the provisions of paragraph (a) of this Section and except as the Association and AGETIP shall otherwise agree, AGETIP shall carry out Part B.14 of the Project in accordance with the Implementation Program set forth in Schedule 4 to the Development Credit Agreement.

Section 2.02. Except as the Association shall otherwise agree, procurement of the goods, works and consultants' services required for Part B.14 the Project and to be financed out of the proceeds of the Credit shall be governed by the provisions of Schedule 3 to the Development Credit Agreement.

Section 2.03. (a) AGETIP shall carry out the obligations set forth in Sections 9.03, 9.04, 9.05, 9.06, 9.07 and 9.08 of the General Conditions (relating to insurance, use of goods and services, plans and schedules, records and reports, maintenance and land acquisition, respectively) in respect of the Project Agreement and Part B.14 of the Project.

- (b) For the purposes of Section 9.07 of the General Conditions and without limitation thereto, AGETIP shall:
 - (i) prepare, on the basis of guidelines acceptable to the Association and furnish to the Association not later than six (6) months after the Closing Date or such later date as may be agreed for this purpose between the Association and AGETIP, a plan for the future operation of Part B.14 of the Project; and
 - (ii) afford the Association a reasonable opportunity to exchange views with AGETIP on said plan.

Section 2.04. AGETIP shall duly perform all its obligations under the Convention and the Subsidiary Agreement. Except as the Association

shall otherwise agree, AGETIP shall not take or concur in any action which would have the effect of amending, abrogating, assigning or waiving the Convention or the Subsidiary Agreement or any provision thereof.

Section 2.05. (a) AGETIP shall, at the request of the Association, exchange views with the Association with regard to the progress of the Project, the performance of its obligations under this Agreement and under the Convention, the Subsidiary Agreement, and other matters relating to the purposes of the Credit.

(b) AGETIP shall promptly inform the Association of any condition which interferes or threatens to interfere with the progress of Part B.14 of the Project, the accomplishment of the purposes of the Credit, or the performance by AGETIP of its obligations under this Agreement, under the Convention and under the Subsidiary Agreement.

ARTICLE III

Management and Operations of AGETIP

Section 3.01. AGETIP shall carry on its operations and conduct its affairs in accordance with sound administrative, financial and educational practices under the supervision of qualified and experienced management assisted by competent staff in adequate numbers.

Section 3.02. AGETIP shall at all times operate and maintain its plant, machinery, equipment and other property, and from time to time, promptly as needed, make all necessary repairs and renewals thereof, all in accordance with sound engineering, financial and educational practices.

Section 3.03. AGETIP shall take out and maintain with responsible insurers, or make other provision satisfactory to the Association for, insurance against such risks and in such amounts as shall be consistent with appropriate practice.

ARTICLE IV

Financial Covenants

Section 4.01. (a) AGETIP shall maintain records and accounts adequate to reflect in accordance with sound accounting practices its operations and financial condition.

(b) AGETIP shall:

(i) have its records, accounts and financial statements (balance sheets, statements of income and expenses and related statements) for each fiscal year audited, in accordance with appropriate auditing principles consistently applied, by independent auditors acceptable to the Association;

(ii) furnish to the Association as soon as available, but any case not later than six months after the end of each such year: (A) certified copies of its financial statements for such year as so audited; and (B) the report of such audit by said auditors of such scope in such detail as the Association shall have

(iii) furnish to the Association such other information concerning said records, accounts and financial statements as well as the audit thereof, as the Association shall from time to time reasonably

request.

Section 4.02. (a) Without limitation upon the provisions of Section 4.01 of this Agreement, AGETIP shall carry out a time-bound action plan acceptable to the Association for the strengthening of its financial management system for Part B.14 of the Project in order to enable AGETIP, not later than 18 months after the Effective date, or such later date as the Association shall agree, to prepare quarterly Project management reports, acceptable to the Association, each of which:

- (iii) sets forth the status of procurement under the Project and expenditures under contracts financed out of the proceeds of the Credit, as at the end of the period covered by said report.
- Upon the completion of the action plan referred to in paragraph (a) of this Section, AGETIP shall prepare, in accordance with quidelines acceptable to the Association, and furnish to the Association not later than 45 days after the end of each calendar quarter a Project Management Report for such period.

ARTICLE V

Effective Date; Termination; Cancellation and Suspension

Section 5.01. This Agreement shall come into force and effect on the date upon which the Development Credit Agreement becomes effective.

Section 5.02. (a) This Agreement and all obligations of the Association and of AGETIP thereunder shall terminate on the earlier of the following two dates:

> the date on which the Development Credit Agreement (i) shall terminate in accordance with its terms; or

- (ii) the date 10 years after the date of this Agreement.
- (b) If the Development Credit Agreement terminates in accordance with its terms before the date specified in paragraph (a) (ii) of this Section, the Association shall promptly notify AGETIP of this event.

Section 5.03. All the provisions of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding any cancellation or suspension under the General Conditions.

ARTICLE VI

Miscellaneous Provisions

Section 6.01. Any notice or request required or permitted to be given or made under this Agreement and any agreement between the parties contemplated by this Agreement shall be in writing. Such notice or request shall be deemed to have been duly given or made when it shall be delivered by hand or by mail, telegram, cable, telex or radiogram to the party to which it is required or permitted to be given or made at such party's address hereinafter specified or at such other address as such party shall have designated by notice to the party giving such notice or making such request. Section 6.02. Any action required or permitted to be taken, and any document required or permitted to be executed, under this Agreement on behalf of AGETIP, may be taken or executed by the Director General or such other person or persons as the Director General shall designate in writing, and AGETIP shall furnish to the Association sufficient evidence of the authority and the authenticated specimen signature of each such person.

Section 6.03. This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original, and all collectively but one instrument.
