Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project became effective in March 2015. Implementation Progress to date remains as Moderately Satisfactory despite good progress made in several key areas, e.g. construction works, strengthening of irrigation and drainage institutions, and the piloting of systematic land registration procedures. On December 16, 2019 a new Law for Water Users' Organizations in Georgia was approved by Parliament. It is now critical to immediately initiate the establishment of water user organization in the pilot areas. The Project received an additional financing of 18.2 million EUR

approved on April 22 2020 by the Parliament of Georgia. As part of an Additional Financing, NAPR is expected to shortly start field activities for systematic registration of land parcels in irrigated priority areas while taking the necessary COVID-19 related safety precautions.

These 43,381 newly registered land plots originate from 12 initial pilot areas. There are additionally around 4,000 applications currently being processed by Local Property Rights Reconciliation Commissions (LPRRC), which will in majority return to NAPR. for registration. The activities of systematic land registration (SLR) in the newly added irrigation areas are currently bein prepared and will start once the Government of Georgia (GoG) approves the decree authorizing the SLF in the irrigated areas. The state of emergency (SoE) related to the COVID-19 pandemics and declared i Georgia on March 12, 2020 is likely to postpone the approval of this decree by at least end of May 2020 On April 10, 2020, GoG added cadastral measurements (surveying activities) to the list of the economic activities not prohibited during the SoE. While this is a positive development for the project, surveying activities represent only part of the complex undertaking that is SLR. The process of title registration includes 3 sets of activities: surveying, preparation of registration packages and public awareness, and registration. The PIU currently reviews the operations manual to adapt procedures and mitigate risks related to the COVID-19.


