> Republic of Armenia: Loan No. 8390-AM (Trade Promotion and Quality Infrastructure Project) Third Amendment to the Loan Agreement and Second Amendment to the Supplemental Letter No. 2

Dear Mr. Janjughazyan,

We refer to: (a) the Loan Agreement ("Loan Agreement") between the Republic of Armenia ("Borrower") and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development ("Bank") dated August 6, 2014, as amended to-date, for the Trade Promotion and Quality Infrastructure Project (the Project); and (b) your letters dated July 17, 2020 and dated October 14, 2020, respectively, requesting the Bank to cancel an amount of USD 2,000,000 from the Loan proceeds.

Please note that unless the context otherwise requires, the capitalized terms used in this Loan Agreement has the meanings ascribed to them in the General Conditions or in the Loan Agreement.

In light of the above, we propose to amend the Loan Agreement as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 7.01 of the General Conditions, the Bank hereby cancels as of July 21, 2020, an amount of two million United States Dollars (US\$ 2,000,000) from the Loan proceeds.
- As a result of above-mentioned cancelation, the table in paragraph 2 under Section IV.A of Schedule 2 to the Loan Agreement is revised to show the new amounts allocated to each disbursement category as set forth in <u>Attachment 1</u> to this Amendment Letter (Amendment Letter).
- The Performance Monitoring Indicators set out in the supplemental letter related to the Loan Agreement dated August 6, 2014, are amended as reflected in the <u>Attachment 2</u> to this Amendment Letter.

4. All other terms of the Loan Agreement, except amended herein, shall remain the same.

Please confirm your agreement on behalf of the Borrower with the above amendments by signing, dating and returning to us one of the original copies of this Amendment Letter. This Amendment Letter shall become effective as of the date of countersignature.
