The Project development objective is to improve irrigation and drainage service delivery to support farmers in the Project areas. This will be achieved through rehabilitation and modernization of irrigation and drainage systems; improved management, operationandmaintenance of these systems; and more efficient use of associated irrigated lands; all with improved participation of users indeveloping and managing the rehabilitated / modernized systems.

Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Implementation Status.

The project is severely delayed both physically and in terms of disbursement with only below 3 percent disbursed after almost 4 years since the date of effectiveness. This corresponds to a cumulative delay of two years from project effectiveness, and while preparation progress has significantly advanced with several contracts already awarded or being awarded and all but two for the remaining irrigation schemes ready for

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MTR highlighted a significant risk that IDIP-2 does not adequately address the technical modernization, the institutional revitalization and the improved service delivery to a changing farming context and has discussed and agreed incremental actions that will help generate lessons in project implementation, as well as analytical work that can help provide a 're-set' to the irrigation dialogue in Kazakhstan to more directly respond to demands for modern technology, job creation, sustainability, commercial farming support in a diversified agro-economy, and a modern investment financing.

Key Decisions/ the MTR mission recommendation are for Borrower to:

- Immediately request for restructuring of the project to revise the disbursement projections, results framework and activity description
 accordingly, and consider potential cancellation of Akdala scheme and reduction of scope of Kyzylkum scheme, which are at high risk of
 not being completed on time.
- 2. By May 2019, request another restructuring to cancel any works contract that have not been awarded by then. In case of no confirmation of adequate budget as per Feasibility Study projections, cancellation of the project (aside from on-going activities).
- 3. Beyond restructuring, to improve the focus on the operation and management, and utilization of the schemes. This includes the piloting of modernization of field delivery systems, piloting of farmer engagement through water user organizations, strengthening on-the-job training for scheme managers and operators, participatory approaches, focus on service delivery and citizen engagement. This includes close monitoring and evaluation of the project and carrying out beneficiary surveys.
- 4. To closely follow up on all deadlines in the MTR Aide Memoir, including activation of Engineer's time-based contract, finalization of the activities on dam safety etc. and; conduct monthly progress meeting with all parties concerned.


