### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project has made tangible progress in both Grenada and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) since the Bank's last implementation support mission undertaken in October 2018.

In Grenada, following the dissolution of the central Project Coordination Unit (PCU) as part of a broader Government re-organization, the project fiduciary and safeguards functions are currently being consolidated at individual departments of the Government (procurement functions at the Central Procurement Unit, financial management functions at Auditor-General's Office, and safeguards functions at the Department of Public Infrastructure and Implementation). The Project Implementation Unit (PIU) has been further strengthened and all key positions including project

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In SVG, the positions of project coordinator, agribusiness/monitoring and evaluation specialist, and an administrative assistant have been filled at PIU. Several project sensitization events have been organized and the detailed proposal on FAO's technical service provision is currently being finalized and the recruitment process of project implementation advisor has been initiated. The project team is currently finalizing the Sub-grants Manual and draft package for a Call for Business Idea Proposals, which are critical documents for launching of the first round of Call for Business Proposals scheduled to take place by May 31, 2019.

There is a need to further expedite project implementation and both countries have agreed on time-bound actions.


