Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project includes three main activities: construction and rehabilitation of small-scale infrastructures, cash transfers and development of a safety net. Its overall implementation is Satisfactory. The implementation of the small-scale infrastructures (component 1) is already completed (microproject were identified during the implementation of the former Community-Driven Development Project). Cash transfer activities and accompanying measures (component 2) and safety net development including impact evaluation (component 3) continue to be Satisfactory. Political instability makes it challenging to mobilize the authorities towards the development of a social protection strategy. The disbursement rate (59%) is above forecast while some additional funds are already committed for future cash transfers.

Project implementation is doing well: (i) 88,700 individuals have benefited from the Project (well above the end-of-project objective of 60,000 individuals) of whom about half are women, (ii) 6,500 individuals have benefited from cash transfers (the end-of-project objective is to reach 50,000 beneficiaries), (iii) 31,300 individuals have been provided access to improved water source (exceeding the end-of-project objective of 15,000), (iv)

30,000 individuals have been provided access to an all-season road (above the end-of-project objective of 7,000). Also, preliminary evidence suggests that there has been an improvement in stunting in children below 2 years of age in households who benefited from the cash transfer program.

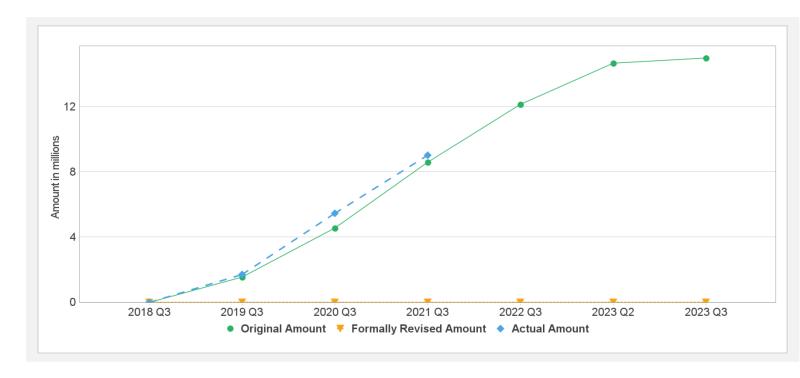
