Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Component 1: Upgrading Vía Expresa Avenue. Regional and municipal governments, as well as civil society representatives, consider the construction of the Vía Expresa a priority and have been very supportive of the project. Detailed engineering designs (Expediente Técnico, ET) were completed in March 2019. The ESIA, including the Resettlement Action Plan, has obtained national clearances from DEGASA. The

4/16/2019 Page 1 of 5 prequalification process for the execution of civil works for the Vía Expresa was completed in December 2017. The bidding and contract award process for civil works and supervision is expected to be achieved in 4th quarter of 2019.

Component 2: Improving Mobility in the Provincial Municipality of Cusco. The municipality finalized a proposal study for the Mobility and Public Spaces Plan in February 2018. This report defines and proposes a vision, strategic programs and projects for sustainable urban mobility and inclusive public spaces in Cusco.
