The overall Project implementation is advancing, albeit at a slower pace. Key actions that have been completed include: (i) First round of Academic Innovation Funds was launched. Selection process of AIF grants is fully completed; (ii) The tender for the development of the Higher Education Management System (HEMIS) was launched in December 2018; and (iii) The tender for the purchase of Labs to improve the learning environment at Universities is expected to be launched in January 2019. These actions are expected to contribute to the quality and relevance of the Higher Education System in Uzbekistan.

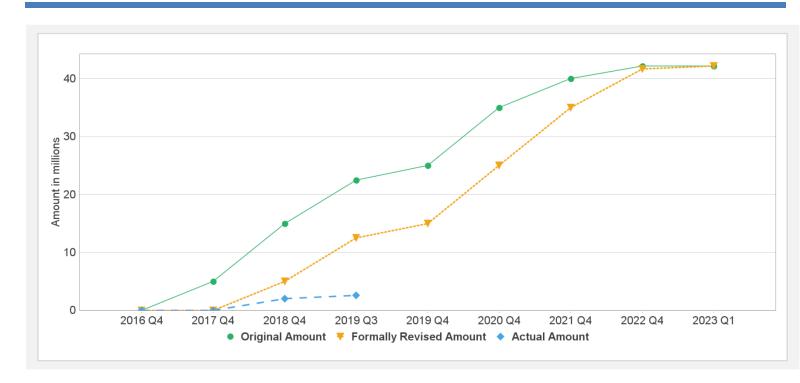
