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Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project continues to make steady progress towards attainment of the PDO. Annual targets on at least five of the nine PDO indicators have been achieved or are likely to be achieved. This could be attributed to improved implementation of project activities. Since the last health mission in October 2020, the major achievement has been on civil works where construction sites at all the targeted 81 health centers have been handed to contractors. Notable progress has also been made on Results-Based Financing, procurement and distribution of medicines and family planning commodities, clinical mentorship of health workers, and adolescent health. However, close follow-up will be required to avert negative effects of the second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic. Since the COVID-19 outbreak, Uganda has experienced significant disruptions in the provision of maternal and child health services. Given the resurgent of cases and new lockdown of 42 days, access to health services is likely to be disrupted further. The World Bank task team will continue working with the Ministry of Health to implement strategies to improve the resilience of the health system through Components 1 and 2 of the project.

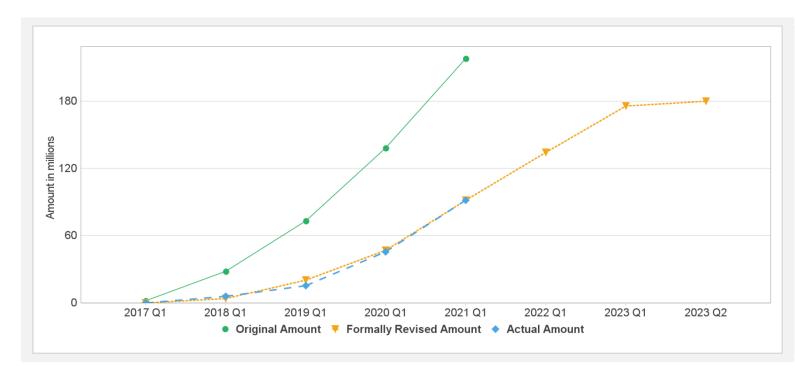
