Implementation Status and Key Decisions

As of November 2020, the overall project disbursement of the World Bank loan is US\$13.28 million (26.6 per cent disbursement rate), and the overall project implementation is rated Moderately Satisfactory. In February 2020, the PDO rating was upgraded to Moderately Satisfactory after the project underwent a significant restructuring to streamline activities under slow disbursing components and extend the closing date by nearly 23 months. As a result, a few secondary and non-performing activities were dropped, and available funds were reallocated to the well-performing priority activities. The project remains highly relevant for the country and provides a timely contribution to Armenia's COVID-19 response through PPP, Innovation Matching Grants and Exporter Development Grants Programs.

Component 1: 12 out of 14 Disbursement-Linked Indicators (DLIs) have been achieved as scheduled. The disbursement rate under the component reached 97 per cent.

Component 2. Promoting Investment and Export demonstrates progress in all four sub-components:

- Subcomponent 2.1: The government engaged the Armenian National Interests Fund (ANIF) to support the implementation of the subcomponent. A consulting contract to design and implement a comprehensive communications outreach to foreign investors for ANIF was signed in September 2020. ANIF is also progressing well in establishing representative offices in major foreign markets. It has opened and operates offices in Moscow and Paris.
- Subcomponent 2.2: The Investment Support Center announced a call for proposals under the Exporter Development Grants Program in January 2020. Overall, 111 applications (requesting about US\$6 million in total) were received and are being evaluated. The counterpart expects to support 5-7 large subprojects utilizing the full budget allocated for this type of grants. The Enterprise Incubator Foundation has received 88 applications under the Innovation Matching Grants Program, of which 23 were shortlisted for pitching, and seven were selected for grant funding and are currently in the contract signing stage with advance payments expected in December 2020. The EIF launched the second round of calls for proposals in August 2020 with a focus on the COVID-19 response, and the received applications are undergoing initial screening.
- Subcomponent 2.3: The Project Steering Committee approved three out of five PPPs (the Engineering City, the Supercomputer Center, and the Cybersecurity Incubator and R&D Lab). For the Engineering City PPP, there has been significant progress in completing the design stage with the master plan approved in July 2020 and the EC infrastructure and Accelerator designs to be approved in December 2020. In parallel, the EIF concluded a contract in May 2020 to procure the Engineering City lab equipment. The contract for procurement of equipment for the Supercomputer Center is expected to be signed in December 2020. In addition, approval of the Advancing High-Tech Education in Gyumri Branch of the National Polytechnic University of Armenia PPP is expected in December 2020.
- Subcomponent 2.4: The Terms of Reference for the General Partner and a Concept of the National Venture Fund (NVF) have been developed and approved. The counterpart is finalizing the full package to announce a call for proposals for potential fund managers. The selection process is planned to be carried out between January-July 2021, with the Fund to be established in September-August 2021.

Component 3:

- The National Institute of Metrology (NIM) signed in February 2020 the contract on Thermal Measurements laboratory equipment, and the equipment was delivered in August 2020.
- The tender for Mass and Related Measurements laboratory equipment was completed, and the contract will be signed in November 2020 with the advance payment planned for December 2020.
- The tender for the design of NIM building refurbishment was completed, and the contract was signed in September 2020. The design works are planned to be completed in December 2020, with the tender for refurbishment works planned to be announced in February-March 2021.
- The contract on the development of the e-accreditation process automation system was signed in June 2020, with the activity to be completed in August-September 2021.
- NIM also started preparing for obtaining international accreditation (DLI 10) in collaboration with the German National Metrology Institute
 (PTB) and plans to complete the process in August 2021 for both laboratories. CEPA funding (EUR 4 mln) was secured to finance
 additional four laboratories to complement the metrology infrastructure funded by TPQI.

Component 4: The PMU is staffed with key personnel and fully operational. The hiring of an engineer, assistant, and M&E expert is completed. The PMU has also been strengthened with an Environmental and Social Specialist.


