- c) Consultancy services by firms estimated to cost Euro 200,000 or more per contract, individual consultant contracts estimated to cost Euro 50,000 or more and single source selection of consultants will be subject to prior review by the Bank.
- d) Short lists composed entirely of national consultants: Short lists of consultants for services estimated to cost less than Euro 200,000 equivalent per contract n entirely of national consultants in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2.7 of the Consultant Guidelines.
