Project Development Objective (from Project Appraisal Document)

The objective of the Project is to improve accessibility to markets for small rural producers in the Selected Areas by: (a) promoting productive alliances between different small rural producer organizations and purchasers; (b) empowering rural producers through the establishment and strengthening of self-managed grass-root organizations; (c) increasing access to productive assets, technologyand financial services; (d) promoting more effective, responsive and accountable service organizations at the local level; and (e)enhancing environmental sustainability of productive practices. The Project is a follow on operation to the successful PAR I, whichtested the model for improving market access.

Implementation Status and Key Decisions

This ISR is based on the findings of a supervision mission carried out between January 27 through 31, 2020, as well as on desk-review update and video-conference calls with the PIU covering the time that has elapsed up to date. Subject to on-going travel restrictions due to COVID-19, the team is considering arranging a virtual mission in July 2020

Implementation progress and progress towards achievement of PDO objectives continue to be Satisfactory. Overall and prior to COVID-19. the Project accelerated implementation through the consolidation of the entire portfolio of investments to be financed by the AF.

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- a) Portfolio of rural alliances subprojects. As of today, the portfolio of approved alliances sums 1031 subprojects, out of which 559 have a signed valid agreement; including the approval of 315 new subprojects at the beginning of March 2020.
- b) Portfolio of public infrastructure subprojects: The Project has identified the first batch of public infrastructure subprojects to be financed under the AF, consisting of 30 subprojects that are at different stages of preparation. Empoderar is confirming the budget capacity of municipalities to provide counterpart funding, given the post-election changes in local authorities and urgent needs derived from COVID-19.

Overall Comments

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Given the nature of the RF focused on measuring results once subprojects have been implemented, current values reported are based on subprojects completed under the original financing. The Project has started the process to conduct the impact evaluation of the original financing and establishment of the baseline for the additional financing.

A total of 603 subproject alliances were financed under the original financing. In additional, a total of 1,000 subproject alliances are expected to be financed under the additional financing; as of today 919 of these have been approved and the remaining ones are expected to be approved by the end of March,/mid April 2020.

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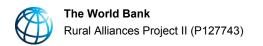

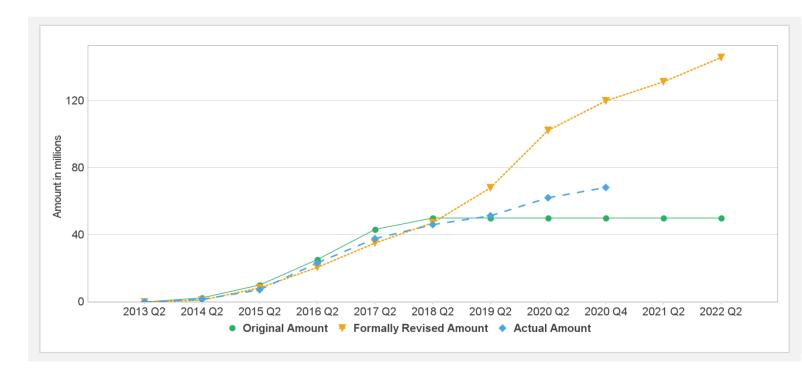
