Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project has made continuous progress. Out of 25 pumping stations (PS) for rehabilitation and upgrading, five PS have been completed; most PS rehabilitation are under construction and the rest have been procured. Component two also made good progress with solid waste management activities being consolidated at facility and community levels to minimize waste accumulating into the PS. Component three has also moved well with the completion of the informal settler families in Vitas, the ratings of component 3 and safeguards were upgraded to MS.


