Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project "Kwenda" is well on track to achieve its development objective to provide temporary income support to poor households in selected areas of Angola, and to strengthen the delivery mechanisms for a permanent social safety net system. Kwenda is being implemented in 9,397 villages and neighborhoods in 214 communes in 61 municipalities across all 18 Provinces of Angola. As of April 2023, (a) the program has registered about 1,005,475 households and paid at least one quarterly cash transfer to about 610,382 households. 63 percent of all cash transfer beneficiaries are women; (b) Integrated Social Action Centers (CASIs) activities have benefited more than 20,000 individuals; (c) 2,184 Agentes de Desenvolvimento Comunitário e Sanitário (Agents for Community Development and Sanitation, ADECOS) have been trained and are directly engaged in implementing Kwenda; (d) about 17,000 individuals participated in productive economic inclusion activities, with the activities indirectly benefiting about 85,000 individuals; and, (e) an innovative grievance redress mechanism, providing near-real-time complaints/ queries from

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beneficiaries continues to be implemented. The project has also initiated a pilot expansion of Kwenda to Cabinda and Cacongo municipalities in Cabinda province.

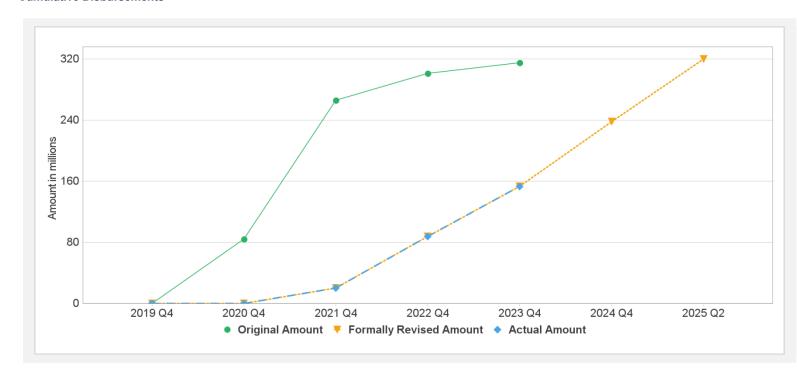
