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4. KEY ISSUES & STATUS

4.1 Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project has demonstrated progress toward the Project Development Objective (PDO), as evidenced by the implementation of project component activities and PDO indicators including an increase in the enrollment of 3-6-year old children in the targeted areas, with females representing 52 percent of the enrollment in the project's target districts. This is attributed in part to sensitization and communication campaigns associated with the project, along with efforts from the Government to increase access to early childhood education (ECE) through the Education for All policy. Construction and related preparation is progressing, with all phase one site validations completed and the development of the Environmental and Social Management Plan (ESMP) concluded and phase one construction starting in 3 provinces in June 2024. Phase two site validations began in April 2024, with site selection, screening, and sensitization for 58 sites scheduled to be completed by July 30, 2024, and the related ESMP to be finalized by August 30, 2024. The project is currently undergoing a restructuring based on the Government's June 2024 request.

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
