Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Implementation of key activities has been completed, and all results indicators that measure improvement of the coverage and quality of basic primary health care (PHC) services in rural health facilities in target districts, have met their end-of-project targets as per the summary below:

- 13,867 health workers were trained (exceeding the end-target of 13,700);
- 720 health facilities-initiated Performance-Based Financing (PBF) (meeting the end target of 720);
- 97.1 percent of PBF facilities have completed household engagement exercises (greatly exceeding the end target of 45 percent)

 481 health facilities were equipped with medical bags, equipment, laptops/tablets to deliver quality primary health care (the end target of 425).

This has resulted in improvement in coverage of health services as follows:

- Percentage of pregnant women who received timely postnatal counseling increased from 90 percent and 68 percent in existing and new
 districts, respectively, in 2019 to 99.7 percent and 99.4 percent in 2023, exceeding end-of-project targets of 95 percent and 93 percent,
 respectively.
- Number of mothers counselled on nutrition increased from 182,452 sessions in 2019 to 326,730 in 2023, exceeding the project target of 290,512.

The Project has also contributed to improved quality of care, as indicated by key indicators measuring quality of PHC provided in Project-supported facilities receiving PBF bonuses:

- Overall, quality scores for rural health centers have risen from 60 percent and 55 percent in 2019 in existing and new districts, respectively, to 91.3 percent and 83.8 percent in 2023. For health houses, during the same period, the quality scores have increased from 51 percent and 50 percent for existing and new districts, respectively to 91.2 percent and 80.5 percent, respectively, over the same period.
- Percentage of hypertension patients treated according to protocol has increased from 80 percent and 20 percent in existing and new
 districts, respectively, in 2019 to 98 percent and 99 percent, respectively, in 2023.

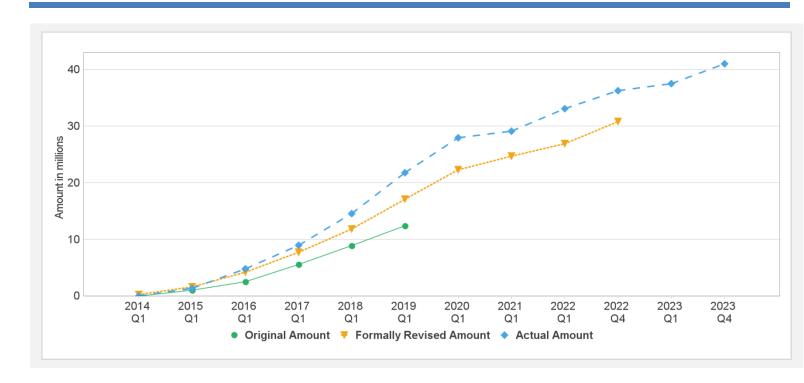
