#### 4. KEY ISSUES & STATUS

#### 4.1 Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Project implementation has been on hold since October 27, 2021, due to the military takeover in Sudan, which led to the World Bank triggering Operational Policy (OP) 7.30, Dealings with De Facto Governments. Key achievements made prior to those events include: (a) 14.4 million textbooks were provided for all basic school students in grades 2-5 (17 titles including math, science, Arabic, and English); (b) Annual School Census was conducted for the 2021/22 school year using local counterpart funding; and (c) curriculum review was carried out with an international firm's technical support.

Project implementation under the regular government-led implementation modalities has not been possible. Therefore, the project was restructured in February 2024 to partially cancel project financing in the amount of US\$52.4 million, with the funds to be repurposed to respond to urgent needs in Sudan through third-party implementing entities as direct recipients since OP 7.30 is in effect. Given the ongoing conflict and continued uncertainties, the request supports the World Bank's aim to respond to multiple shocks in Sudan through third parties. The cancellation and reprogramming of canceled amounts through third-party implementing entities under new projects have been endorsed by the Global Partnership for Education (GPE), the grant provider for the Basic Education Support Project.


