Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Sindh Integrated Health and Population Project aims to improve the utilization and quality of basic Reproductive, Maternal, Newborn, Child and Adolescent Health plus Nutrition (RMNCAH+N), for poor and vulnerable populations, especially women and children, in targeted areas of Sindh. The Project was approved by the World Bank's Board of Executive Directors on December 19, 2022 and became effective on January 13, 2023. The Project Management Unit (PMU) has been established with some critical staff on board and the project's designated account has also been opened. The procurement plan has been approved by the Bank, and the procurement activities have been initiated accordingly. Implementation will need to be expedited as the project's development objective is dependent on the completion of the civil works related to the health facilities that

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have been damaged during the flood. Accordingly, a timed action plan has been agreed with the project management unit to fast-track implementation progress.


