Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project continues to make progress under two contracts under the project, F0 – Lot 2.B (Zemo Osiauri to Chumateleti) and F1 (Chumateleti-Khevi Section of E-60 Highway) have achieved progress of 43% and 50%. The Contractors are still facing difficulties with bringing skilled workers



and modern equipment on site that would be a key factor for improving their performance on works for tunneling, bridges and retaining walls. The Roads Department and the Ministry of Regional Development and Infrastructure will closely monitor the work on site to ensure improvement in pace of implementation.

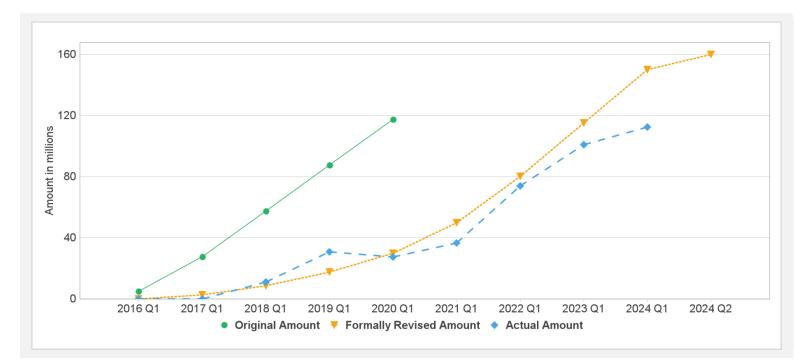
