Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Project implementation continues to exceed expectations and all components of the project have shown strong performance, with most targets being achieved much ahead of the project end date. A large number of women continue to approach Citizen Facilitation Centers (CFCs) to seek health services, CWG and vital registration (CNIC) services, demonstrating the efficacy of project design. The project has successfully deployed 42

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of planned 43 CFCs. A large segment of the population in target districts has already received support though the Child Wellness Package with the number of beneficiaries reaching over 1.36 million. The project has utilized all of its funding, and will close in June 2024.

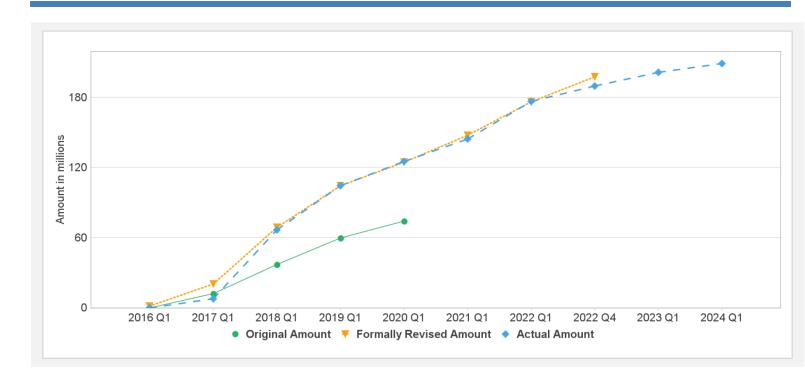
