## Implementation Status and Key Decisions

This is an interim ISR, based on exchanges with the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) on implementation progress. As of this reporting, initial delays in contracting of the World Food Program (WFP) to lead implementation of project activities meant to provide immediate support and relief to vulnerable food insecure populations in targeted regions have been resolved and the necessary contract signed on July 28, 2023. Through this contract, eligible beneficiaries will be provided with conditional cash transfers linked to their participation in labor intensive public works for construction of community infrastructure that contributes to reducing vulnerability and increasing resilience to climate shocks. The first disbursement

to WFP is underway and WFP is now mobilizing their teams and finalizing the beneficiary targeting process to enable roll out of field activities in the month of October 2023. Contracts are also being processed to bring the South West Development Authority (SOWEDA), the Mission de Developpement du Nord-Ouest (MIDENO), Caisse de Developpement de l'Elevage du Nord-Ouest (CDENO), Caisse de Developpement du Nord (CDEN), and the Mission de Developpement des Peches du Cameroun (MIDEPECAM) on board as implementing partners/service providers for project activities in support of project activities focused on strengthening productive capacities of smallholders through crop and livestock support for climate and nutritional resilience. It is expected that these contracts would be signed by the end of October to allow for a speedy roll-out of project activities. In the interim, work on preparation of the Food Security Crisis Preparedness Plan (FSCPP) for Cameroon is under way. As of this reporting, a draft report of the stocktaking of food crisis management mechanisms in the country has been produced and a technical workshop to validate the findings is planned for October 10, 2023. Once finalized, the FSCPP will enable Cameroon to systematize country operational arrangements for effective and early crisis response.


