4. KEY ISSUES & STATUS

4.1 Implementation Status and Key Decisions



The Wildlife Conservation Bond (WCB) was issued on March 31, 2022, and the project was declared effective on March 28, 2022. To date, six disbursements have been made, amounting to 68% of the total project funds. Key project staff have been appointed and have received training; ESF instruments developed for the project have been disclosed at AENP and for GFRNR and are currently being used to guide project activities. Priority procurement packages have been successfully processed, and monitoring effectiveness continues to be a priority. Procurement, financial management, and environmental and social performance ratings remain satisfactory. The T0-T2 estimations have been completed (and T3 is well-advanced), with verifications for T0 and T2 also finalized. The Rhino Population Growth Rate (CAGR), as calculated by the calculation agent and verified by the verification agent at T2, stands at 7.65%.
