Excellency:

We refer to (i) the Financing Agreement between Republic of Ghana (the “Recipient”) and the International Development Association (the “Bank”) for the above-referenced Project, dated May 22, 2023.

We also refer to the letter from the Recipient No. ERMERD/WBGU/FSRP/VOL-II, dated 08 December 2023, requesting the financing of fertilizers by the FSRP Program and the reallocation of funds between disbursement categories. We are pleased to inform you that the Bank agrees with the request and hereby amends the Financing Agreement as follows:

1. A new item (d) is added to Part 2.2 of Schedule 1 to the Financing Agreement to read as follows:

"d) Supporting the provision, traceability and smart-subsidies of fertilizers"

2. The table set forth in Section III.A of Schedule 2 to the Financing Agreement is amended as set forth in the Annex1 to this letter (Amendment Letter).

All other terms and conditions of the Financing and Grant Agreements that have not been amended hereby shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
