### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

This is the final ISR prior to the Project's closing now slated for January 30, 2023, following the last restructuring dated October 27, 2022 which extended the original closing date of October 30, 2022. The Project is on track for an orderly closure. One additional round of data collection is expected to be completed by December 2022, to be reflected in the ICR report, and expected to confirm the Project's achievement of objectives. Below is the current status of achievement of the Project's objectives and PDOI targets, as of this ISR.

Objective 1: Strengthen public management of the education sector. PDOI1. Use of an Education Management Information System (EMIS) to enable national implementation of the QAS. The end target--"EMIS implementation: data utilized for decision making by MENFP"--has been achieved.

Objective 2: Improve learning conditions in selected public and non-public primary schools. *PDOI2. Net proportion of schools supported by the Project that improve their school learning conditions score.* As of April 2022, 81% of schools supported by the Project have improved their learning conditions score, significantly surpassing the end target of 30%.

Objective 3: Support enrollment of students in selected public and non-public primary schools.

- PDOI 3.a: Community education grants for school access. The end target (16,000 children) has been surpassed, with 38,470 children cumulatively enrolled in community-based schools over the Project life.
- PDOI 3.b: *Tuition waivers to non-public schools*. The end target (16,500 children) has been surpassed, with 22,141 children enrolled in non-public schools via the tuition waiver program during SY18. This program was then closed as planned, and the Project directed further support to non-public schools via a results-based financing program.
- PDOI 3.c: Results-based financing to non-public schools. The end target (91,000 children) has been surpassed, with 119,718 children cumulatively enrolled in non-public schools via the results-based financing program.
- PDOI 3.d: "Full package" support to public primary schools. The end target (120,000 children) has been largely achieved, with 115,519 children cumulatively enrolled in public schools benefiting from the "full package" of QAS interventions, and is expected to be surpassed with new data to be collected by December 2022.
- PDOI 3.e: "Light package" support to public primary schools. The end target (98,000 children) has been surpassed, with 107,196 children cumulatively enrolled in public schools benefiting from the "light package" of QAS interventions.

This target has been largely achieved. An additional training on gender-based violence was planned for September-October 2022, but is no longer possible due to the severe country context. It has also been confirmed to be essentially impossible to achieve the 100% target even if every teacher/director has received at least one training related to gender, because the Project's M&E system to date has not been set up to uniquely identify each teacher/director participating in a certain training. For these reasons, and given multiple urgent competing priorities, neither a rescheduling of the GBV training nor the organization of another gender-related training is planned before Project closure.


