

1. Home Section


dataset

Explore the 'Data' section where information can be browsed, accessed, and consumed from an organized repository of data assets.






Dataset


Selecting a dataset on the 'Data' section lists details about the dataset along with relevant metadata.





Data View


A data view is a report showing a slice of data derived from a dataset. The features are similar to what is explained in "Dataset" section.

Just like with a dataset, a visualization can also be accessed from the 'Data' section.




Financial Results

The 'Financial Results' section offers financial statements and ratios from World Bank Group institutions in a 5-year comparative table. Additional historical data can be accessed via linked datasets and PDFs under financial statements.




Countries / Economies

The 'Countries/Economies' section details the World Bank Group development projects for a specific country/economy, categorized for search by name, region, and income group. This serves as a single reference point for users interested in a specific area.



Summaries

The 'Summaries' section presents key financial information through graphical time series and tables, with options to filter and drill down into details. The information can also be printed for further use.



Publications

The 'Publications' section features key financial publications from the WBG, categorized into Procurement, Financial Instruments, Trust Funds, and Financial Intermediary Funds (FIFs).

Glossary

The 'Glossary' section, organized alphabetically, offers a summary of various terms used across the platform.
