

**Per Capita Income Guidelines for Operational Purposes**

The per capita Gross National Income (GNI) guidelines covering the Civil Works Preference, IDA Eligibility, IBRD Terms and the initiation of IBRD graduation process are updated every year, based on the annual rate of change of the SDR-deflator [see President's Memorandum to the Executive Directors dated September 27, 1983 (SecM83-924)]. The updated operational guidelines to be applied during FY21 are as follows:
