Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project has made significant progress since the last mission. Nearly 3 million rural households have been mobilized into 244,830 Self-Help Groups, further federated into more than 14,500 Village Organizations and 51 Cluster Level Federations. The pace of capitalization has picked up with more than 25000 SHGs receiving ICF since the last mission. 39,500 Self-Help Groups have leveraged institutional credit from banks within 6 months of the project. More than 50,000 SHG households have been mobilized into Producer Groups and the project is scaling up several value chain initiatives originally initiated under BRLP in new districts. The project has reached more than 160,000 households with Behavior Change Communication (BCC) pertaining to Health, Nutrition and Sanitation. Community Institutions have emerged as key stakeholders in sanitation initiatives, undertaking large scale social mobilization and orientation, resulting in greater demand for access to sanitation facilities at the household level.

The project has been proactive in addressing the priorities identified in the last mission. The training methodology for VOs/CLFs has been revised and a resource pool of nearly 300 trainers has been created and trained on new case based teaching methodology. Grading of SHGs and VOs has been initiated and is being scaled up. The project MIS has cleared all backlog pertaining to profile entries of community institutions and has initiated the process of transaction entries. Recruitment process for major vacant positions has been initiated and is expected to be completed soon. Two new pilots on Digital Finance have been initiated and several new partners have come on board to support key thematic interventions.

Going forward, the project will focus on the following key actions

- 1. Roll out a VO transaction based MIS and develop mobile based applications for the new initiatives launched under the project
- 2. Strengthen technical assistance from the State Project Management Unit (SPMU) to districts by creating new positions at the SPMU level and reconfiguring the state team to deliver customized support for different set of districts.
- 3. Focus on monitoring of Bank Linkage in terms of overall quality, utilization (disbursement) and renewals. Additionally monthly monitoring of progress along specialized initiatives (Agriculture, livestock, skills, health, nutrition and sanitation) will be institutionalized.
