- Geographic: rural, peri-urban, urban, nomadic communities, IDPs and returnees,;
- Economic: self-employed women, women in business as employers and employees, un/underemployed women, farm workers; and
- Social: rural and urban poor and underserved women, with a particular focus on impoverished,

women-headed households, households with women as income earners, and/or who are illiterate or have limited education.
