**Re: Republic of Cameroon: Grant Number 4984-CM
 Cameroon Sanitation Project – Phase I
 Amendment to the Financing Agreement**

Excellency:

We refer to the Financing Agreement dated October 28, 2011, (the “Agreement”), between the Republic of Cameroon (the “Recipient”) and the International Development Association (the “Association”) for the above-referenced project (the “Project”).

We also refer to your letter dated February 23, 2015, requesting specific amendments to the Agreement. Please note that capitalized terms used in this letter (the “Amendment Letter”) and not defined herein have the meaning ascribed to them in the Agreement.

We are pleased to inform you that the Association accedes to your request and proposes, through this Amendment Letter, to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The legal name of the Project as appears on the cover page of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

“Cameroon Sanitation Project”.

2. Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the he Preamble of the Agreement are amended to read as follows:

“ WHEREAS (A) the Association has received a letter from the Recipient, dated May 12, 2011, describing a general orientation for a national sanitation strategy;

(B) the Recipient, having satisfied itself as to the feasibility and priority of the Project (as defined below), has requested the Association to assist in the financing of the Project;”

3. Article 3.01 of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

“3.01. The Recipient declares its commitment to the objectives of the Project. To this end, the Recipient shall carry out Parts B and C of the Project through MINEE in

accordance with the provisions of Article IV of the General Conditions and cause Part A of the Project to be carried out by the CUD in accordance with the provisions of Article IV of the General Conditions and the Project Agreement.”.

4. The second paragraph of Schedule 1 to the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

“The Project consists of the following parts:”

5. Part B of Schedule 1 to the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

“Part B: Rural Sanitation

Implementation of a program of activities to increase access to improved sanitation in Target Areas, consisting of:

1. Design and implementation of outreach and education activities for hygiene and hygiene behavioral change and creation of demand for sanitation services;
2. Construction of household latrines consisting of: (a) pits and slabs; and (b) superstructure; and
3. Construction of public toilets, boreholes and wells; and establishment and training of borehole committees in schools and health centers.

6. Section IV.B (2) of Schedule 2 to the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

“2. The Closing Date is March 31, 2017.”

7. The table set forth under Section IV.A (2) of Schedule 2 to the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the table as shown in the Attachment to this Amendment Letter.

8. “Paragraph “22” of Section I of the Appendix to the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following paragraphs renumbered accordingly.

9. A new paragraph 33 is added to Section I of the Appendix to the Agreement and the following paragraph renumbered accordingly:

“33. “Target Areas” means the Extreme North, East, North and the Adamaoua regions of the Recipient’s territory.”

Please confirm your agreement with the foregoing amendments by signing and dating this Amendment Letter in the spaces provided below. Henceforward, all other provisions of the Agreements not hereby amended shall remain in full force and effect. This Amendment Letter shall be executed in three counterparts each of which shall be an original.


