VOLUME IIPrefaceThe Consolidated Account of Social Spending

Before the mission that gave rise to this report, there was no consolidated account of social spending in Brazil. The federal government, the semiautonomous social funds, state and local governments carried on their programs with only a general awareness of the overall sources and uses of funds in the social sectors, and how the activity of each might affect the others. It seemed timely to attempt to construct a consolidated account for reasons discussed in some detail in the report: federal programs affect state and local action; spending by the social funds affects private decisions and the availability of private services, and; it is difficult to detect how policy changes and different systems of program delivery might affect the equity and efficiency of services without a consolidated account.

The consolidated account of federal social spending and the social funds presented in Annex I requires the following caveats. Agrarian reform and rural development spending has not been included, but other rural programs have been, such as social security, health care, water, and sanitation. This inconsistency should be eliminated in any future preparation of a social budget.

The proper treatment of social security and medical insurance benefits also present issues. To the extent that benefits are fully funded by affiliate contributions, so that no subsidy component is included, such programs are not comparable to other social services, which do constitute subsidies to the recipients. However, as the report shows, there is a potentially large subsidy component in the Brazilian social security system because contributions do not cover likely future benefits, creating a gap that will have to be financed out of general revenues.

A significant component of pension benefits consists of payments to government employees. These payments are about 10 percent of federal social spending and 25 percent of state and local government social spending. These payments have been counted as part of social spending on two grounds. A large share of them are nonwage compensation for government employees who deliver social services. This nonwage compensation has to be offered to public employees to compete with compensation offered in the private sector so that it is a cost comparable to similar benefits in the private sector and should not be left out of account in this consolidation of social spending.

The data on social security include pension benefits of public employees. The amounts included at the federal level were about US\$2.2 billion in 1986. Federal transfers to the pension funds of state and local government were under US\$0.3 billion. The government pension scheme is only roughly equivalent to the SINPAS system. Further conceptual work on the appropriateness of inclusion of these payments in a consolidated account of social spending is warranted.

The data in Annex I were extracted from the Balancos da União, detailed accounts of federal spending, and from the reports of SINPAS, BNH, FAS, FINSOCIAL, and other social funds. The data extracted were regrouped functionally, a difficult technical task. Health spending, for example, occurs in several different ministries and under a wide variety of sub-categories. Major expenditures are listed by three code levels -- sector, program, and sub-program, and there are dozens of smaller expenditure groups consolidated under the generic term, "Other expenditures in health." These details can be checked by reference to the book of codes used for the Balancos.

It was a considerable feat to prepare Tables 1 through 8 and 1A through 8A, based on treasury documents. An even greater task was that of combining treasury data with information from the social funds, SINPAS, FAS, BNH, and FINSOCIAL. Each of these funds operates with different accounting principles. It was not until the formation of SEST, the secretariat for state owned enterprises, in the early 1980s that federal authorities began to get a clear picture of the financial transactions of the social funds and the banks and other enterprises supported by them. A World Bank mission in 1982 and SEPLAN prepared a consolidated account of the central government, *Consolidacao Plurianual dos Programas de Governo (CPPG)*. That effort in turn helped provide essential technical guidance for the preparation of the current consolidated account.

The consolidated account of federal social spending appears in summary form in Tables 14 and 14a, the former in current cruzeiros/cruzados, the latter in constant cruzados of 1986 value. These tables are the principal underpinnings of tables in the text which describe federal social spending. In some cases data were converted to US\$ equivalents. Because of several large devaluations that occurred in the 1980s, it was not informative to convert each year's cruzeiro/cruzado values to dollars. Instead current values were converted to cruzados of constant 1986 value (US\$1 = Cz\$13.7), and these values were converted to US dollar equivalents. The dollar buying power was significantly greater, for most products, than this simple exchange-rate transformation would imply.

Of greater difficulty than manipulation of federal data was the consolidation of state and local spending with that of the federal government. The source for spending by these governments is a special survey conducted periodically by FIBGE (Medici 1987). The last complete data cover the year 1984. The source eliminates double counting of transfers between states and municipios, but it does not identify federal funds that may be included in the accounts of state and local spending. Double counting was eliminated from the education, health, and housing areas by reference to other sources (Winkler 1987, Vetter 1987), and may not be a problem in other categories of spending.

Despite these efforts to reduce double counting, some transfers from the federal government may still appear twice in the analysis presented

in the main text of this report -- as federal spending, and as part of state and local spending.

Data from 1984 were used to extrapolate to 1986, by assuming the same rate of growth as that of GDP. Given the observed expansion of federal social spending during this period, from 7.9 percent of GDP to 9.1 percent of GDP, and the possibility that state and local spending grew as much as federal social spending, the data in this report may underestimate state and local social spending in 1986.

The consolidation eliminates double counting via internal transfers between the federal treasury and the social funds. With respect to the flow of funds between state and municipal governments, the methods employed also eliminate this source of double counting.

Much work remains to be done to assure the internal consistency and aptness for planning and budgeting of this system of consolidation. As suggested by a member of the SEPLAN working group, data available through the Ministry of Finance could further improve the consolidation, and elimination of double counting, of federal, state, and local government in the expenditure in the social sectors.
