Supplemental Contribution Amendment to the Administration Arrangement between the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Development Association concerning Climate Innovation Multi-Donor Trust Fund (TF071681)


Dear Ms. Hughes:

1. We refer to the Administration Arrangement between United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, acting through the Department for International Development (the "Donor") and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Development Association (collectively, the "Bank"), regarding the Climate Innovation Multi-Donor Trust Fund (the "Trust Fund") (TF071681) effective as of September 23, 2011, as amended (the "Administration Arrangement").
2. We are pleased to acknowledge, on behalf of the Bank, the intention of the Donor to make a supplemental contribution to the Trust Fund in the amount of eighteen million Pounds Sterling (GBP 18,000,000) (the "Supplemental Contribution").
3. The Donor shall deposit the Supplemental Contribution into such bank account designated by the Bank in installments in accordance with the following schedule:
 - (a) promptly following countersignature of this Amendment by the Donor and submission of a payment request by the Bank, six million six hundred thousand Pounds Sterling (£6,600,000);
 - (b) on or before December 1, 2014 and upon submission of a payment request by the Bank, four million and one hundred thousand Pounds Sterling (£4,100,000);
 - (c) on or before June 1, 2015 and upon submission of a payment request by the Bank, three million and nine hundred thousand Pounds Sterling (£3,900,000);
 - (d) on or before December 1, 2015 and upon submission of a payment request by the Bank, one million and nine hundred thousand Pounds Sterling (£1,900,000); and
 - (e) on or before June 1, 2016 and upon submission of a payment request by the Bank, one million and five hundred thousand Pounds Sterling (£1,500,000).

4. When making the deposit, the Donor shall instruct its bank to include in its payment details information (remittance advice) field of its SWIFT payment message, information indicating: the amount paid, that the payment is made by Donor for TF071681 (the Climate Innovation Multi-Donor Trust Fund) and the date of the deposit. In addition, the Donor shall provide a copy of the Donor's deposit instruction to the Bank's Accounting Trust Funds Division by e-mail sent to tfremitadvice@worldbank.org or by fax sent to (202) 614-1315.
5. Immediately upon receipt of the Supplemental Contribution funds, the Bank will convert such funds into United States Dollars.
6. All other terms of the Administration Arrangement shall remain the same and will apply to the Supplemental Contribution.
7. The Bank will disclose this Amendment and related information on this Trust Fund in accordance with the World Bank Policy on Access to Information. By entering into this Amendment, the Donor consents to disclosure of this Amendment and related information on this Trust Fund.
8. Please confirm your understanding to the foregoing, on behalf of the Donor, by signing, dating, and returning to us one of the enclosed originals of this Amendment. Upon receipt by the Bank of the original of this Amendment countersigned by you, this Amendment will become effective as of the countersignature.
